Job is funded by a grant from the state of New Mexico's Youth Conservation Corps; paid work focuses on trail building, and outdoor education and appreciation.

- 2) Positions are open to ages 14 to 25.
- Anyone who was hired and worked for The Family YMCA's YCC program in the Summer of 2018, may return the first two pages of this application only (no further references or YMCA job application required).
- 2 non-family reference forms, end of this application, are required (*only people who worked on the Y's trail crew in the Summer of 2018 do not need these references). These reference forms, once completed, should be <u>re-attached to the application</u> and turned in by March 11, 8 am.
- 5) Make sure you read and understand the job description that you are applying for at <u>www.laymca.org.careers</u>.
- 6) Only experienced trail builders will be considered as a Leader.
- 7) Trail or outdoor work experience highly desired; but the Y will consider those who are highly motivated to engage in outdoor work as expressed in application questionaire.
- 8) Position is 36 hrs-full time, Monday through Thursdays, 8am-4:30pm, and 8am-12pm on Fridays with occasional longer times on Fridays. Bus passes to Los Alamos will be provided to hired crew from outside the town.
- Applications must be received by Monday, March 11, 8 am (or sooner). Applications may be turned in to The Family YMCA, the Los Alamos Teen Center, or the Española Teen Center. <u>Incomplete or late applications will disqualify the applicant.</u>
