OUR MISSION:

To build individual, family and community strength by focusing on youth development, healthy living and social responsibility... and to ensure access to all.

Each year the Y serves 8,000 people through healthy living programs, including 300 locals in 150 families who are on financial assistance.

In 2017, donors provided charitable gifts to The Family YMCA totaling \$172,000.

This breaks down to helping 200 children attend programs (86 of which were in Y Afterschool and Camp programs), and 100 adults have a membership. The Y awarded \$126,000 in these areas.

Designated donations also supported programs at our teen centers in Española and Los Alamos that collectively served 2,500 youth. A total of \$46,000 in Annual Campaign dollars went toward our teen centers in 2017.

Donations help to improve lives... 1 in 4 kids in our afterschool and camp programs is on aid, and 1 in 28 adults at our Y is on assistance.

The Y anticipates the need for a 3% increase in scholarships, and \$50,000 for the teen centers.
